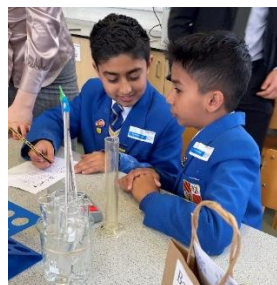
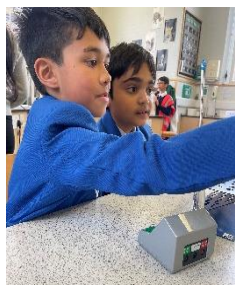
Sayan (Ruds): For noticing that Ma'am did not have a hymn book and immediately gave his to her. *Spotted by: Miss Buglass*
