

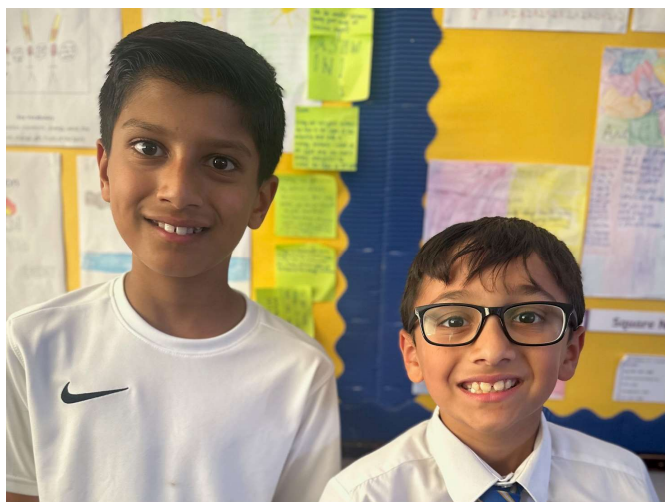

UNIFORM REMINDER: In September, we will return in summer uniform and this includes **shorts with long socks for ALL boys except Rudiments** (who have the choice throughout the year of trousers or shorts).

SCHOOL CAPS: We have come to the sad decision that we will no longer have the cap as part of the school uniform. The overwhelming deciding factor was the cost and with a proposed price increase of approx. 40% for September it was felt that this was not a realistic expectation for parents. The sun hat and woolly hat (with the Loyola badge) are still part of the uniform and must be worn in line with school policy.
