Figs: Ashwin and Sayan

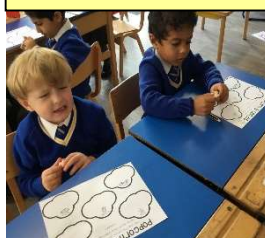
