Figures visited the Royal Observatory at Greenwich as they are learning about space and the solar system



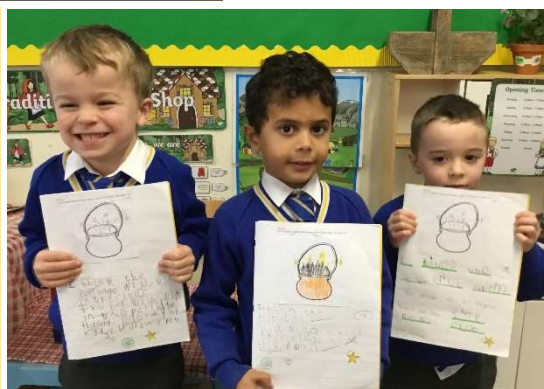

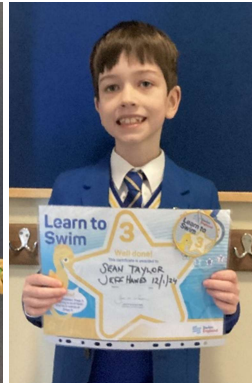
AMAZING NEWS!
