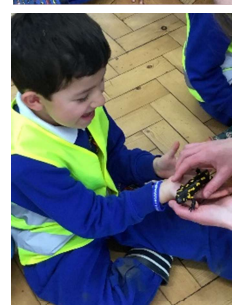
***Congratulations to Ashwin as he has been selected to represent England in chess!***
